# ***The Professional MC's Cheat Sheet***

***Use for - Panel Discussion, Conducting an Interview, Thanking a Speaker, Facilitated Q&A, Pre Briefing a Speaker and much more. (Also useful for your own Networking conversations)***

What's the one question you wish people would ask you?

*(This is such an excellent question as it allows the Speaker to go in any direction they want. If they have forgotten anything in their main presentation or they want to put emphasis on any point in a more casual manner. It can also be treated in quite a funny manner as well)*

What's a Typical day for you? *(The difference between what people think you do and what you actually do. Can get fun responses)*

Big Wins in the Last Year? *(For the person, group, company etc)*

Challenges – *(what are the main challenges for the Industry, City, Community etc ...?)*

Opportunities *(what are the big opportunities for ... ?)*

What more could be done *( by the organisation, people, community, Government)*

What more can we do as individuals?

The Next 12 Months? What would you really like to see happen?

How do you Prioritise projects?

What is happening right now?

What are the changes you see?

Government / Regulatory What factors are putting pressure on the industry?

Foreign Ownership / Intervention – What factors are putting pressure on the industry?

Are there any

- Best Practices?
- Role Models?
- or Case Studies that you could tell us about?

*(Great to give the audience some examples that they can look up or investigate.)*

Are they doing this better – Overseas? in another State/ City?

Last Advice for Audience? What can they implement straight away when they get back to work?

*(Another great audience connecting question. Allows the Speaker to finish on a Big Challenge.)*

And don't ever forget the Journalists Friends –

- Who?
- What?
- Where?
- When?
- Why?
- How?

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Pop this list into your Notebook and you'll always be ready to keep the discussion moving along or have a question to start a Q&A session.

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
